Wakagetti Indigenous Corporation (WIC) are hosting a cultural camp for Children / Young People (CYP) in Out Of Home Care (OOHC) at our property on Paynes Crossing Rd, roughly 3km from Wollombi Township.

Our Target Audience: Aboriginal children in Out of Home Care (OOHC).

Aboriginal children comprise 5.5% of all children in Australia yet constituted 36.2% of all children placed in OOHC. The Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) population projection data for 2015-16.

Many of these children don't have the means to build upon their cultural identity. A strong cultural identity is important to a child's mental health and well-being. Having a strong sense of their own culture and traditions helps children build a positive cultural identity for themselves, gives them a sense of belonging and self-esteem and supports their overall health and well-being.

Our Solution: Cultural Camps for Aboriginal children in OOHC

In order to address this need we have created 3, three day tailored programs to expose children in OOHC to instances that will build their knowledge of their own cultural identity and traditions.

Program features include: Aboriginal storytelling, weaving, sites visits, traditional dance, bush tucker gathering, didgeridoo, Aboriginal artifact demonstration, Aboriginal Art workshops and more.
